Rules for Participation:

Candidates for this program must apply to the NJSC Ski Education & Instruction Committee Chairman by completing this application. This program is open to all NJSC Ski Club members who want to learn to be ski/snowboard instructors. Applications must be new candidates for ASIA certification and sponsored by their club. Fill out this form and send it to Ed Dalton via mail or email to the address shown below. In order not to lose any time, please email me at skiinstruction@newjerseyskicouncil.org and let me know which program you are interested in registering for. Upon receipt, I will email or call you confirming your eligibility.

In order to take advantage of this program, you need to fill out two applications. The 1st is an Application for you to be a member of ASIA, and there is an application fee of \$25.00. The second application is the Program Application for your Level 1- 4-day instruction program and the cost is \$220.00. The NJ Ski Council will reimburse half of the Pre-Course & Exam fee after the candidate passes the exam. **Upon passing the exam, please forward me a copy of your certificate & cancelled check.** You or your club will be reimbursed, one half of the \$220.00 course registration fee. If the candidate is not successful in passing the exam on the first try, the Ski Council will pay the fee after an exam retake and successful completion.
